# Sounds2Sound GPX Files- Guidance Notes

## Introduction

These notes are to assist riders on the 2022 Sounds2Sound brevet ride. The GPX files are based on the best available information I've been able to gather; it is however always the rider's responsibility to navigate safely through the course.

# The Route

The main route is a tad under 1,500km and has just under 21,000m of climbs. To keep me sane and allow Course Notes and a book to be produced the routes is split into these 21 sections.

#### **GPX Files**

When making GPX files it is always a balance between detail and number of points and many GPS units struggle to handle files with more than 2,000 points. So, as well as providing one file for the full route and files for each of the 21 sections (and 5 Alternate Options) I have also provided the route split into five main segments each with under 2,000 points. (Figure 2). As well as the Main Route there are some Alternates Route Options that you may need to use.

#### Simplest

If manipulating GPX files is something you are not skilled at I'd suggest that you use just use the files in these folders (Figure 2)

- '5 Main Route GPX Files'
- 'Alternate Route Options GPX Files'.

You will need to work out how load them onto your GPS!

Each of these files shows the *Section Number* (01-03), *length* (244km) *climb* (4,660m up) and the *Start* and *End* point. (Figure 3). The *Alternate Options* files are similar (Figure 4).

#### Slightly more work

If you don't want to edit files but want to use smaller lengths, then use the '21 Main Route Sections GPX File' and 'Alternate Route Options GPX Files'. Each of these files shows the Section Number (01), length (69km) climb (2,040m up) and the Start and End point. They all start and end at key locations and may tie into places you are staying.




Figure 5 Example details of '21 Main Route Sections GPX File'

#### Advanced

Depending on your skills with GPX files you can combine / trim / edit the 1 *Full Route GPX Files* and 'Alternate Route Options GPX Files' to produce your own route from the 10,000 point 1 'Full Route GPX File'. Good luck!
